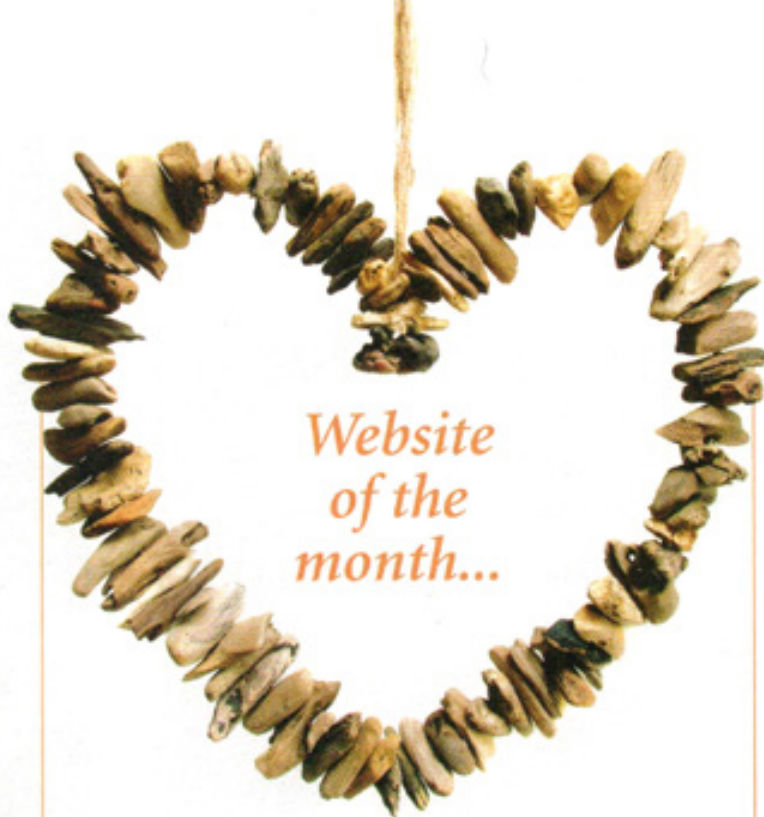

The museum is open daily from 10.30am-6pm and admission costs £9.50 for adults and £5 for children; under 4s go free.



## DON'T MISS...

The chance to discover a hidden architectural gem near you at a Midsummer Tea Party from 17-19 June, organised by The Churches Conservation Trust. This is the second year the event has taken place, following the 2010 launch where 80 churches took part and raised over £15,000 for the conservation and restoration of historic churches at risk of falling into disrepair. To date the charity has saved more than 340 buildings, which attract 1.5 million visitors a year.
